However, each of you who contributed to KIFB during 2012 certainly made a difference in the lives of more than 145,000 people who were served by KIFB and the collaborative agencies we partner with. This includes over 60,000 children, nearly 60,000 adults, and over 24,000 seniors. In addition we provided over 1,000 emergency food boxes. KIFB also distributed 750 turkeys for Thanksgiving to more than 20 agencies which were distributed through their food pantries.


